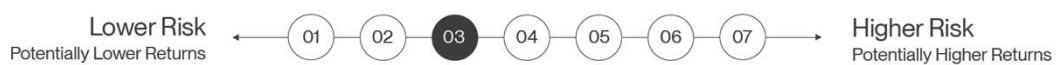
Description of this Fund

The Fund invests in fixed income securities that are classified as “Green Bonds”. The Fund’s investments are managed by Affirmative Investment Management.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Pathfinder Green Bond Fund:





The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund’s assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

Example of how this applies to an investor

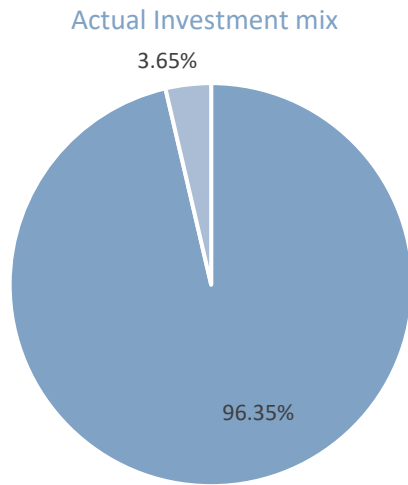
Angela had \$10,000 in the fund at 27 January 2023 and did not make any further contributions. At the end of June 2023, Angela incurred a loss after fund charges were deducted of \$57 (that is -0.57% of her initial \$10,000). Angela did not pay any other charges. This gives Angela a total loss after tax of \$39 for the period (0.39%).



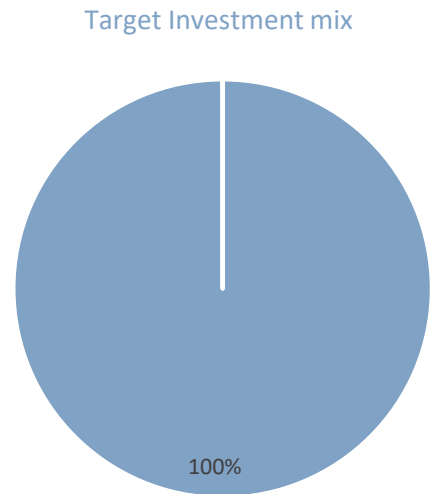

The top 10 investments make up 41.18% of the net asset value of the fund.

Currency hedging: Changes in the value of the NZ dollar relative to other currencies can have a big impact on your investment over the long term. The target currency hedging level implemented in the fund is 100% of foreign currency exposures (actual hedging level at 30 June 2023 was 99.34%, this will change over time). The unhedged foreign exposure was 0.64% of the Net Asset Value of the fund at 30 June 2023 (this will change over time).

Notes:

- Risk indicator:** This risk indicator is not a guarantee of a fund's future performance. Market index returns as well as the fund's actual returns have been used to fill in the risk indicator because the risk indicator is calculated using returns data for the five-year period ending on 30 June 2023. Market index returns have therefore been used for the period from 1 July 2018 to 27 January 2023 when the fund was not in existence, and actual fund returns have been used since then. As a result of those returns being used, the risk indicator may provide a less reliable indicator of the potential future volatility of the fund. While risk indicators are usually relatively stable, they do shift from time to time. The risk indicator will continue to be updated in future fund updates.
- Performance Return:** Return after deduction for charges and tax (-0.39%) is higher than return after deduction for charges but before tax (-0.57%), this is due to tax credit received since fund started trading.
